Fabric samples include fabric cleaning codes and instructions. Professional Dry Cleaning is recommended.

- **S** Spot clean only with a water-free dry cleaning solvent. Pretest a small, inconspicuous area before proceeding. Do not saturate. DO NOT USE WATER. Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to restore appearance. Cushion covers should not be removed and dry-cleaned. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to remove dust and grime is recommended. When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Clean spots or stains from the outside to the middle of the affected area to prevent circling. **Overall cleaning by a professional furniture cleaning service only is recommended.**
- Spot clean only with water based shampoo or foam upholstery cleaner. Pretest a small, inconspicuous area before proceeding. Do not overwet. Do not use solvents to spot clean. Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to restore appearance. Hot water extraction or steam cleaning is not a recommended cleaning method. Cushion covers should not be removed and laundered. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to restore appearance is recommended. When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Clean spots or stains from the outside to the middle of the affected area to prevent circling. **Use a professional furniture cleaning service when an overall soiled condition has been reached.**
- WS Spot clean with upholstery shampoo, foam from a mild detergent, or mild dry cleaning solvent. Pretest a small, inconspicuous before proceeding. Do not saturate. Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to restore appearance. Hot water extraction or steam cleaning is not a recommended cleaning method. Cushion covers should not be removed and laundered or dry cleaned. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to remove dust and grime is recommended. When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Clean spots or stains from the outside to the middle of affected area to prevent circling. **Use a professional furniture cleaning service when an overall soiled condition has been reached.**
 - Clean only by vacuuming or light brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush. **DO NOT USE ANY WATER OR SOLVENT BASED CLEANER.**

NOTE ON RAYON CONTENT FABRICS

The rayon chenille yarn behaves in a very similar manner to a pile fabric or velvet in that the yarn has a tendency to crush or compact, resulting in light or white areas in the fabric. Our suppliers have tested each of these fabrics and they have met all industry standards for performance and durability. This pile distortion can be removed through steaming and light brushing, but these conditions may reappear over time. Claims for this condition as defective fabric cannot be accepted as this is a natural and inherent condition of rayon chenille fabrics.
